Notice is hereby given that Great Torrington Town Council, as the relevant qualifying body, has submitted the Great Torrington Neighbourhood Plan proposal to Torrington District Council in accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

The Great Torrington Neighbourhood Plan establishes a vision for the evolution and long-term sustainability of Great Torrington and provides policies and proposals to guide development within the designated area over the period up to 2031.

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), representations on the neighbourhood plan are invited from interested parties during the period **from Thursday 14th February until 12 noon on Thursday 28th March 2019**. Late representations will not be accepted.
