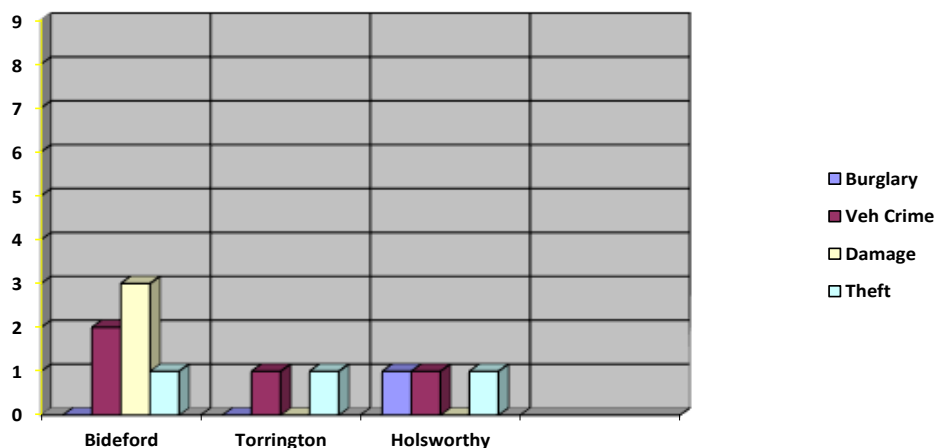
PLEASE NOTE The information below is obtained from Selected Reported Crime Incidents, restricted and sanitised, taken from Crime Sheets prepared by the Police for the Torrridge District and are not Official Police Figures, and only refer to crimes of Theft and Damage. We live in one of the safest low crime areas in England and Wales. *To get a more realistic view of all crime committed in Torrridge you can visit the Devon and Cornwall Police Website.*

Fear of crime in our area is far worse than the actual crime committed.



This Week's Crime Statistics.

After having 17 reported crimes of Theft and Criminal Damage committed in the whole of Torrridge last Report, this week we have with 11 crimes recorded on 7 days.



During the last week 6 crimes were committed in the Bideford area, 2 in the Torrington Area and 3 in the Holsworthy area. We had 1 Burglaries, 4 Vehicle Crimes, 3 of Damage and 3 of Theft. 0 Arson

We had 0 Dwelling Burglary, 1 Non-Dwelling Burglaries, 1 Thefts of Vehicle, 0 Theft from Vehicle, 3 Theft Non-specifics, 0 Theft Pedal Cycle 3 Damage to Vehicles, 3 Damage to Dwellings, 0 Damage non-Dwellings and 0w Damage Non-specifics. 0 Arson

We have had 3 incidents included in the above of "Contained Domestic Incidents" and because they do not affect anyone else, under the Data Protection Act, this restricts us to what information we can pass on.

This last week 3 crimes were committed in our towns and 8 in our rural areas.
