#### Fear of crime in our area is far worse than the actual crime committed.










#### This Week's Crime Statistic's.

After having 14 reported crimes of Theft and Criminal Damage committed in the whole of Torridge last Report, this week we have with 17 crimes recorded on 7 days.



During the last week 8 crimes were committed in the Bideford area, 6 in the Torrington Area and 3 in the Holsworthy area. We had 2 Burglaries, 7 Vehicle Crimes, 3 of Damage and 5 of Theft. 0 Arson

We had 0 Dwelling Burglary, 2 Non-Dwelling Burglaries, 0 Thefts of Vehicle,

- 3 Theft from Vehicle, 4 Theft Non-specifics, 1 Theft Pedal Cycle 4 Damage to Vehicles,
- 3 Damage to Dwellings, 0 Damage non-Dwellings and 0w Damage Non-specifics. 0 Arson

We have had 5 incidents included in the above of "Contained Domestic Incidents" and because they do not affect anyone else, under the Data Protection Act, this restricts us to what information we can pass on.

This last week 9 crimes were committed in our towns and 8 in our rural areas.
