

# Green Wheelie Bin

To have your garden waste collected **fortnightly** you will need to subscribe to the service. The service subscription period runs from 1st June 2022 to 31st May 2023.

Subscribers will receive a permit sticker to place on their bin – only green bins with a sticker will be emptied by the Council.

## Green Box

- ✓ Plastic Bottles
- ✓ Food Trays, Margarine Tubs, Yoghurt Pots
- ✓ Food Tins/Drink Cans
- ✓ Aluminium Foil
- ✓ Aerosol Cans (no tops)
- ✓ Household batteries (place in a small clear plastic bag)
- ✓ Small electrical items

- ✗ Black plastic
- ✗ Cling film & plastic bags
- ✗ Light bulbs
- ✗ Car batteries
- ✗ Engine oil bottles
- ✗ Fast food packaging
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Saucepans & baking trays
- ✗ Plant pots of any colour



Please wash & squash your plastics and tins.

## Green Bag

- ✓ Newspapers/Magazines
- ✓ Catalogues
- ✓ General Paper (including shredded paper)
- ✓ Envelopes (not brown)
- ✓ Sheets/Curtains
- ✓ Duvet cover/Pillow Cases
- ✓ Shoes (pairs only)
- ✓ Clothing (1-3 items)

- ✗ Non Paper Items (from junk Mail)
- ✗ Drink Cartons
- ✗ Wrapping Paper
- ✗ No Plastic
- ✗ No pillows or duvets
- ✗ Pet food pouches



## Brown Bag

- ✓ Flattened Cardboard (no tape or staples)
- ✓ Egg Boxes
- ✓ Greeting cards (no glitter)
- ✓ Corrugated Cardboard
- ✓ Brown paper and envelopes

- ✗ Tetra/ drink cartons
- ✗ Sawdust/ Wood shavings
- ✗ Fast food packaging
- ✗ Coffee cups



Please ensure cardboard is in the brown bag. You can request a second bag or break up larger pieces to fit.

## Food Caddy

- ✓ Bread & Pastries
- ✓ Dairy Products
- ✓ Meat & Bones
- ✓ Tea leaves & Bags
- ✓ Coffee Grounds
- ✓ Fish & Fish Bones
- ✓ Fruit
- ✓ Vegetables
- ✓ Salad Items
- ✓ Cut Flowers

Your food waste will be collected **Weekly** alongside your recycling boxes and bags. (Additional caddy can be requested for larger households).

Please use a **line caddy**. This can either be with corn starch bags or you can re use other forms of plastic bags such as bread bags or carrier bags. This will ensure no food waste is left behind in your caddy. We advise cleaning your caddy regularly to avoid a build up of food waste.



## Black Box

- ✓ Bottles
- ✓ Jars

- ✗ Broken windows
- ✗ No glassware
- ✗ No Pyrex
- ✗ No ceramics
- ✗ No plastic
